As we launch the third year of Sampad Associate Schools we are delighted to share with you our 2025-26 brochure. Alongside our usual offer of Artist workshops, assemblies and our ever popular **My Journey My Birmingham** Theatre in Education performance, you have the opportunity to book two exciting new shows.

**Celebration of Diwali** will be touring in the Autumn and replaces **Spirit of Light** which schools have enjoyed for the past few years. 'Celebration of Diwali' is suitable for Year 2 and above and takes place in your hall. Our other new offer is **Lori**, which is aimed at 3-6 year olds and will tour from January–March 2026. **Lori** is a multilingual interactive storytelling performance for our youngest audiences, which includes a free CD and book for each school so that you can use the music and songs throughout the year.

Whilst you are welcome to book a one off session, our Associate Schools not only receive a free two-week residency of our schools' exhibition **City of Empire to City of Diversity** (with accompanying Heritage CPD and online materials), but also a 10-20% discount on all additional services.

Following the success of our **Meet the Creative Careers Assemblies** and **Drama and Oracy INSET** (offered free to Sapphire Tier Schools) we have decided to open this opportunity up to all schools for 2025-26.

Over the past year, the most popular workshops with both primary and secondary schools have been our **Bollywood/Bhangra Flashmob dance lessons**. We have been delighted to see such joy and enthusiasm, not only from the children but also from staff involved, as they have performed in playgrounds, halls and even lunch recess spaces. Our **art workshops** have also proved popular, particularly those linked to cultural celebrations such as Diwali, Eid or Holi. Mindful of budgetary constraints, we are offering additional discounts if you book 2 artists on the same day (see page 6). ## Workshops and Performances

We provide a wide variety of creative opportunities and are happy to work with you to plan the best fit for your individual school setting. We have a mix of performances which are linked to specific areas of the curriculum and are also open to working in partnership with you to commission new work.

We are a cross arts organisation and have professional artists who work in schools from a wide range of art/cultural forms. All our artists work within our safeguarding policy and we work with you to ensure the best possible experience for both artist and school community.



### Artists Workshops

## Dance Opportunities

Sampad has a longstanding international reputation for developing and supporting dance artists. We have dancer-facilitators who will work with your students to understand, learn and perform a piece, tailored to meet their needs and in the time frame you would like. We have artists skilled in a wide range of South Asian dance forms including: Bharatanatyam, Kathak, Bhangra and Bollywood.



### Artist Led Dance workshops for KS1, KS2, KS3 and Special Schools

- Book a weekly dance artist to teach your dance module for half a term.
- Plan an enrichment day where students learn South Asian dance to retell a traditional Indian story.
- Learn and use dance gestures to explore oracy.
- Learn a specific South Asian dance genre for half a day and perform it for your Arts Award.
- Run taster workshops for Year 9 students who are keen to take dance in KS4.



### Artist Led Dance Workshops for KS4 and KS5

- Masterclass session/project in a specific genre of South Asian Dance for BTEC/GCSE/A Level.

## Visiting Musician Assemblies

- Half Day: 2 x 30 minute assembly performances, AM or PM (maximum audience 60 children for each performance), £300
- Full Day: 4 x 30 minute assembly sessions, £450
- KS4 music students – 90 minute performance with discussion (maximum size of group 20-30), £295



## Introduction to South Asian Dance Assemblies

- Half Day: 2 x 30 minute assemblies, AM or PM, (maximum 60 students for each assembly), £375

Meet 2 professional South Asian dancers who will lead an assembly performing a number of different South Asian Dance styles, explaining their significance. They will also teach the assembly group a number of hand gestures used in some traditional dance forms.

- Full Day: Same as Half Day offer, plus 4 x 30 minute dance taster sessions (maximum 32 students for each taster session), £750



These taster sessions for 4 of your classes will deepen their understanding of this art form.

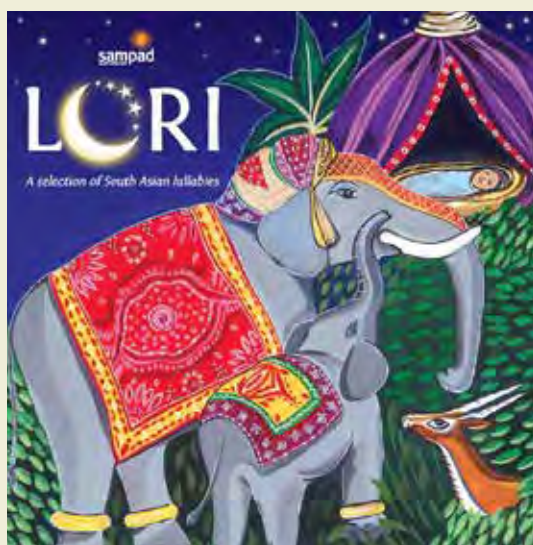


## A Celebration of Diwali October-November 2025

Suitable for age 7 and above

Following on from the success of 'Spirit of Light', this is a new interactive performance which explores the stories and traditions of Diwali through storytelling, dance and music. Each show will last approximately 45 minutes and can be performed to an audience of up to 90 children.

- 1 performance: £400

This is a 40 minute interactive storytelling and movement performance using lullaby music from South Asia.

This is suitable for one class (maximum 30 children) at a time.

Each school will be given a CD and Lori picture book following our visit.

## My Journey, My Birmingham

My Journey, My Birmingham is a Theatre in Education performance. It tells the imagined stories of people from the Dyche collection – an archive of images of people who migrated to Birmingham after World War 2. The performance explores through interactive theatre and drama activities some of the sacrifices they made and prejudices they faced, as well as their aspirations as they rebuilt their lives in the city.

The performance is suited for one class (max 32 children) and lasts 90 minutes\*. It can be booked as a standalone event, or also before, during, or after your From City of Empire to City of Diversity: A Visual Journey Exhibition (see page 15).

# Sampad Associate Schools Exclusive



## City of Empire to City of Diversity: A Visual Journey

The From City of Empire to City of Diversity: A Visual Journey schools exhibition is a smaller version of Sampad's original exhibition, which was at The Library of Birmingham in 2022. Presenting key features from the project, alongside striking photographs by Ernest Dyche, this mini-version is the perfect stimulus for conversations around migration and diversity. Small enough to fit anywhere in the school, previous schools have displayed it in the hall, for all students to see on their lunch break.

Accompanying the exhibition are comprehensive classroom resources, including oral histories, storytelling and an interactive map, which have already equipped teachers with the skills to confidently discuss the heritage of people from Birmingham with thousands of young people.

Sapphire Schools will be given priority up to 18th August 2025.

All remaining slots will then be filled in the order that booking sheets are received.

Supporting online materials including oral histories and archive footage are free to all schools.

A set of A4 laminated photographs are on loan for the duration of the residency.

A free Heritage CPD will be run to support schools in making the most of their exhibition residency. Associate Schools will be offered a free place (Autumn Term date tbc).
